Thanks to the hard work of Amanda Solvason and her team of teenage pool helpers, the pool house, furniture and, the pool are ready for use. Early birds may use the pool now but are requested to clean up after themselves and leave the umbrellas in the down, stowed position. The current "Pool Rules" are reprinted below:

## POOL RULES

Hours: 9:00am - 10:00pm

WARNING – NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY- SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK The rules are intended to ensure members and guests a safe and enjoyable facility. Members and guests who utilize the facility knowingly consent to the assumption of risk and waiver of the liability since there is no lifeguard on duty. It is the responsibility of the member to inform their guests of the rules.

## **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Children 12 years of age and younger must be supervised by an adult 18 year of age or older. Unattended solo bathing is prohibited.
- 2. Children 2 years of age and younger, or any other incontinent persons, must wear snug fitting plastic pants or wear water resistant swim diaper.
- 3. No glass articles allowed in or around the pool.
- 4. No food, drink, or wrappers shall be permitted within 10 feet of the pool.
- 5. No running or rough play allowed. No person may use the swimming pool or tennis courts in a manner that, in the discretion of the BOD, creates a nuisance or unreasonable disturbance to other users and/or causes or is likely to cause damage to Association property.
- 6. No spitting, spouting of water or blowing nose in pool.
- 7. Persons using the pool must wear swimsuits. No "cut offs" allowed.
- 8. No swimming allowed during heavy rain or when thunder and lightning can be seen or heard.
- 9. No smoking or vaping.
- 10. No pets allowed in the tennis court or pool areas.
- 11. Any injuries should be reported to Emergency 911 immediately.

## **MEMBERS**

1. Membership privileges are subject to suspension by the Board of Directors after a violation of the rules by a member or their guest. There will be no refund of dues if the board finds this action necessary. The Board may also levy fines for violation of these pool rules.

2. Residents of the Horsemen's Run subdivision who are delinquent in dues are ineligible to utilize the pool or tennis courts.

3. A member who allows the improper use of their key to allow unauthorized individuals to enter the pool is subject to having their pool/tennis court privileges suspended.

4. If a member or guest is found trying to enter or exit the pool/tennis area without properly using the gate they will be subject to having their pool/tennis court privileges suspended.

5. All members and guests must depart the pool area by 10:00 pm.

## **GUESTS**

- 1. Other than family members, guests are limited to 4 per family.
- 2. Guest(s) violating the pool rules will be asked to leave.
- 3. Guests must always be accompanied by a member in good standing
